新聞稿

無良大學排行榜理大遭冠 錦大工資最低 要求規管外判工資：工資 33 元 8 小時工作

飲食及酒店業職工總會（職工監屬會）在 2009 年 10 月至 2010 年 2 月期間，進行大學外判員工的特唔和職業安全調查問卷調查，邀請學生義工協助，共訪問了 238 名來自 7 所院校外判管理的員工。

基層工友受剝削 工資極低逼零錢

受訪基層員工的平均工資為 23.9 元，平均月薪只有 5,965 元，當中 55.6% 的工人每月收入更少於低收入線級的水平（即 6,240 元，計算方法見附件一）。調查發現各大基層員工的平均工資僅低只有 21.6 元，而其中港大的屹亞公司（大家樂集團）的綫面清潔員工，月薪 4,751 元，每天工作 10.5 小時，月薪僅得 17.4 元。

他被情況不只基層工友受害，調查發現大學外判餐廳的技術／管理級員工工資一般較業界出色，當中以快餐樓面主任及大厨的差距最大，分別較業界低 17.7% 及 16.9%，可見薪酬倒向其他工種蔓延。

若以兼金飯換算時薪 30 元的水平計算，合共有 156 名受訪工人的時薪比這水平更低，其中以港大（29 人），城大（27 人）及浸大（24 人）的受影響工友最多，而當中受惠於大家樂集團旗下屹亞的低薪工友高達 61 人，佔低薪工友的 4 成。大家樂作為院校中最大的外判承辦商（估計得薪了約 310 人），又是本港的上市公司，其主席陳裕光作為最低工資諮詢委員會的成員，其所屬集團卻以優厚薪資吸引技術性的工作，實在頗為諷刺。

工時長危急職業安全 等級化削就業穩定

數據顯示連同全職員工共 141 人平均工作時間為每天 9.7 小時，工時比其他行業為高，當中 3 成受訪者表示需要加班，其中 71% 受訪者工時達 10 小時或以上，其中城大重工則工時最長，達每天 10.8 小時。在職業安全方面，分別有 23.7% 受訪理工僕及 51.9% 受訪廚工僕是「經常性勞累」，手肘、手背、腿及膝蓋，當中以理大則工僕及勞務問題嚴重，分別有達 4 成及 7 成有工傷及職業病的情況。

「無良大學排行榜」理大奪冠

工會綜合員工特唔、學院化、職業安全及健康忠告書，明確未討外判合同的監督，兩年前工會曾進行同廠的調查，並去信相關承辦商要求就外判餐廳的待遇問題開會面，最後，浸大校方雖與工會會面，但總結未有全面改善外判制度以保障工人權益，工資依然低於生活的基本需要，未能確保工友的生計。事實上，對比兩年前的狀況無甚改進，平均工資及工時並無顯著改進。

調查發現工長十分期望校方對校園內的勞工狀況作出更大的承諾，而達 69.7% 的受訪者質疑校方在外判合約時訂立工資下限，規定月薪平均為 30.9 元；同時，亦有 87.4% 受訪者質疑成立工時規管，在質成的受訪者中，建議工時報薪每天 8 小時或以下的有近 7 成，期冀工時平均為 8.2 小時。作為負責任的院校，理應局負教育者的使命，決不可助封堵嘴，工會現公開籲約各大學校長參照，采取妙方：

1. 回應工友的訴求，在招標時設立足以應付基本生活開支的最低時薪要求，不低於 33 元，及限制工時不可多於 8 小時；
2. 引入工會教育，促進勞工待遇及職業安全，長遠建立平等的勞資談判機制；
3. 接受與工會會面的公開邀請，仔細討論保障勞工權益的措施及改善外判制度的時間表及步驟。

1. 大眾外判樂團「樂風排行榜」

調查顯示易屋全職員工(共 141 人)平均工作時間為每天 9.74 小時，工時比其他行業為高。當中 3 成受訪者表示需要加班，其中 71%受訪者工時達 10 小時或以上。至於工資方面，受訪易屋全職員工的平均工資為 23.9 元，平均月人只有 5,965 元，當中 55.6% 的工人每月收入更少於低收入線的水平(即 6,240 元，詳法見附件一)。

綜合員工待遇、零散化、職業安全及健康等因素，理大為「無良排行榜」之冠，其次為兩大及兩大，調查發現兩大區屬員工的平均工資最低只有 21.6 元，屬工比創過 4 成，而其中港大泛亞（大眾樂團）*的模擬表演員，月薪 4750，每天工作 10.5 小時，月薪僅得 17.4 元。而理大則工場及房務問題嚴重，分別有逾 4 成及 7 成基層員工有工傷及勞損，城大基層員工則工時最長，每天工時高達 10.8 小時。

飲食及酒店業職員待遇問卷調查 大學外判職工總會調查

調查背景及方法

調查於 2009 年 10 月至 2010 年 2 月間舉行，訪問員先後到訪 7 所大學（中大、城大、浸大、理大、科大、港大、科大），分別以面對面及電話問卷形式訪問了共 238 名大學外判職員（人數分析見下表）。問卷內容涵蓋員工的工時、工資、工傷、病假及數化等情況，並了解其對最低工資及標準工時的看法。

3. 與 2007 年比較

比較 2 年前工會局調查結果，數據顯示 2 年來該職員工待遇未有明顯改善，當中最大的平均工資更大幅下降了 10.7%，反映院校在勞外判職員合約並未作出有效監督，至於高階工會前會計後情況無改善，但水工管平均仍屬優良性，工務方面則以城大總工程大、升幅逾 1 成半，是大工幅及勞資協商明顯加劇，升幅分別 2 成半及超過 3 成。

In December 2007, the Chief Executive ("CE") submitted a report to the Standing Committee of the National Peoples Congress ("NPCSC"), reflecting faithfully the views on universal suffrage received during the public consultation on the Green Paper on Constitutional Development. Having considered the report, the NPCSC made clear the universal suffrage timetable:

- The CE in 2017 may be elected through universal suffrage by all registered electors of Hong Kong (i.e. one-person-one-vote);
- All members of the Legislative Council ("LegCo") may be elected by universal suffrage in 2020.

Rolling forward constitutional development in 2012 will be conducive to Hong Kong's implementation of universal suffrage. The Government is now consulting the public on how to further democratize the CE and LegCo elections for 2012 under the principle of gradual and orderly progress.


This leaflet introduces the main directions that may be considered.

DHKFS, HKUSUC Session 2010:

今日下午，學聯發起三二八青年踢走功能組別遊行，由港大國殤之柱經中聯辦遊行至禮賓府，往禮賓府途中，警方封路阻擋遊行人士，更無理拘捕學聯成員、理大學生會會長黃佳鑫。

我們對警方無理拘捕示威人士，打壓和平示威活動，嚴重侵害香港市民之公民權利深表憤怒。

我們強烈譴責警方濫用警權，要求警方立即釋放黃佳鑫同學，並就事件解釋及道歉。

公民抗命有理 抗議警方打壓

要求警方立即釋放黃佳鑫

學聯於今日下午二時半發起「青年踢走功能組別遊行」，近百名參與者包括大專學生、青年及民間團體。遊行隊伍到達禮賓府門後，警方架起人牆及鐵馬阻截，並以公眾安全為理由阻止隊伍前進往禮賓府正門。期間主辦單位代表與警方交涉路線安排，但警方一再拖延，且缺乏誠意與參與者溝通。部份參與者感到鼓躁，遂自行繞小路前往正門。警方再次攔截，一度發生衝突，在僵持期間，警方將學聯成員黃佳鑫押倒在地，並將他強行拖離現場，帶往警署，而且沒有當場交代原因。

學聯認為此並非個別事件，事實上近幾個月來不斷拘捕以至檢控社會人士，以圖製造白色恐怖，藉此打壓民間運動。是次事件激化的責任明顯在於警方安排，學聯強烈譴責警方的拘捕行為，並堅決認為面對制度不公，公民抗命無罪，重申我們反對<公安條例>的立場。

學聯要求警方立即釋放黃佳鑫，並將反對任何警方檢控。
